

God is mighty

Psalm 93:4 *Mightier than the thunder of many waters, mightier than the waves of the sea, the LORD on high is mighty!*



For a few years my family and I (only three children then) lived in the Scottish Highlands. Looking out of the window of our house I could see one of my favourite things. I would often spend ages gazing out of the window at it. It is very large and has shaped much of human history. Almost everyone has heard of it and most people have probably seen it. Many people make special trips to see it but at the same time others are scared of it. It has been the inspiration for much music, painting, poetry and literature. It is the sea.

When the Psalmist wants to say how mighty God is, it is to the picture of the sea he turns. Like God, the sea can be the most peaceful, relaxing, beautiful thing in the world. Many people want to live beside it (and will sometimes pay a small fortune to do so) or spend their holidays travelling to different parts of it. There is little that can compare in beauty to the sun setting into the horizon across the sea. To sit quietly beside the sea and hear the lapping of the waves can refresh our souls and lift our spirits just like the Lord. Yet, like the Lord, the sea can be the scariest thing in all creation because we cannot control it. It can be wild and frightening, with the power to overturn ships, collapse cliffs or wash away entire cities. The sea is uncontrollable. In the centuries-old battle between humanity and the sea, the sea always wins. So the Psalmist chooses the sea to compare to YHWH's might.

You think the sea is powerful, untameable and mighty? You don't know what those words mean until you have seen the powerful, untameable and mighty God. He is not just mightier than the sea, He made it. The sea may seem uncontrollable to us (which it is) but YHWH is totally sovereign over it. He demonstrates this fact to Job by asking "who else shut up the sea behind doors when it burst forth from the womb, when I made the clouds its garment and wrapped it in thick darkness, when I fixed limits for it and set its doors and bars in place, when I said, 'This far you may come and no farther; here is where your proud waves halt?'" (Job 38:8-11).

The sea can be both powerful and peaceful at the same time, like The Lord. The sea is there day in, day out, whether we notice it or not, like The Lord. The sea cannot be controlled or domesticated by humanity, like The Lord. But the sea was created by The Lord as a pointer to his breath-taking power and might. He is God Almighty.
